ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 13th day of October 1993

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 4 (1) of the Marine Reserves Act 1971, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting on the recommendation of the Minister of Conservation made under section 5 (9) of that Act with the concurrence of the Minister of Fisheries and the Minister of Transport, and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Marine Reserve (Tonga Island) Order 1993.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Marine reserve constituted—The area described in the Schedule to this order is hereby declared to be a marine reserve.

DESCRIPTION OF THE RESERVE

All that area comprising 1835 hectares, more or less, situated in the Nelson Land District, being part of the seabed and foreshore, and being more particularly shown marked "A" on S.O. Plan 15105 lodged in the office of the Chief Surveyor for the Nelson Land District.
