



**THE MEAT RATIONING ORDER 1944**

---

PURSUANT to Regulation 8 of the Rationing Emergency Regulations 1942\* (hereinafter referred to as the regulations), the Minister of Supply and Munitions hereby makes the following Order.

---

**ORDER**

1. This Order may be cited as the Meat Rationing Order 1944.
2. This Order shall come into force on the 6th day of March, 1944.
3. The following goods shall be rationed goods for the purposes of the regulations—namely, all meats, including meat products containing a substantial proportion of meat.
4. The retailers of the rationed goods hereinbefore referred to shall be licensed under the regulations.
