**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At Wellington this 6th day of April 1992

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. J. B. BOLGER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 4 (1) of the Marine Reserves Act 1971, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the recommendation of the Minister of Conservation made under section 5 (9) of that Act with the concurrence of the Minister of Fisheries and the Minister of Transport, and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Marine Reserve (Kapiti) Order 1992.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Marine reserve constituted**—The area described in the Schedule to this order is hereby declared to be a marine reserve.

## DESCRIPTION OF THE RESERVE

All that land comprising 2167 hectares, more or less, situated in the Wellington Land District, being part seabed, and being more particularly shown marked "A" and "B" on S.O. Plan 36790 lodged in the office of the Chief Surveyor for the Wellington Land District.
