

# THE MEDICAL RADIATION TECHNOLOGISTS REGULATIONS 1982, AMENDMENT NO. 4

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to paragraphs (d) and (m) of section 40 (1) of the Medical Auxiliaries Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

# REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Medical Radiation Technologists Regulations 1982, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Medical Radiation Technologists Regulations 1982\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
  - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1989.
- 2. Fees—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 10 (as substituted by regulation 3 of the Medical Radiation Technologists Regulations 1982, Amendment No. 3), and substituting the following regulation:

- "10. (1) The fee for registration as a medical radiation technologist shall be \$50.00.
- "(2) The fee for a certificate of registration as a medical radiation technologist shall be \$22.50.

"(3) The fee for an annual licence issued to a registered medical

radiation technologist shall be \$33.75.

- "(4) The fee for any alteration in, or addition to, any entry in the register other than a change of address or change of name on marriage or correction of an error for which the person registered is not responsible, shall be \$11.25.
- "(5) The fee for restoration of a name to the register under section 21 of the Act shall be \$39.38.
  - "(6) The fee for inspection of the register shall be \$22.50.
- "(7) Subject to regulation 6 (4) of these regulations, the fee for a certificate of temporary registration shall be \$45.00."
- **3. Fees inclusive of goods and service tax**—The fees fixed by these regulations are inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.
- **4. Revocation**—Regulations 3 and 4 of the Medical Radiation Technologists Regulations 1982, Amendment No. 3 are hereby consequentially revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 July 1989, prescribe a new and increased scale of charges payable under the Medical Radiation Technologists Regulations 1982, to reflect the increase in goods and services tax.
