THE MOTOR SPIRITS DISTRIBUTION REGULATIONS 1955,
AMENDMENT NO. 1

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 25th day of February 1958

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Motor Spirits Distribution Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Motor Spirits Distribution Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor Spirits Distribution Regulations 1955* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 13, and substituting the following regulation:

“13. In respect of each retailer’s licence there shall be payable by the licensee an annual licence fee as follows:

For a licence to sell motor spirits through one pump only	£1
For a licence to sell motor spirits through two or more pumps only	£3
For a licence to sell motor spirits through one pump and otherwise than through pumps	£3
For a licence to sell motor spirits through two or more pumps and otherwise than through pumps	£5
For a licence to sell motor spirits in any manner except through pumps	£3”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations prescribe a new scale of fees for retailers' licences under the Motor Spirits Distribution Act 1953.
