THE MOTOR SPIRITS DUTY REGULATIONS 1961

COBHAM, Governor-General ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 25th day of October 1961

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Motor Spirits Duty Act 1961, and to section 71 of the Sales Tax Act 1932-33 as applied by subsection (2) of section 3 of the Motor Spirits Duty Act 1961, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Motor Spirits Duty Regulations 1961.
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of December 1961.

Interpretation

2. In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires,— "The Act" means the Motor Spirits Duty Act 1961:

Expressions defined in the Act or in the Sales Tax Act 1932-33 have the meanings so defined:

A reference to a numbered form is a reference to a form so numbered in the Schedule to these regulations.

Application of Sales Tax Regulations 1933

- 3. (1) Subject to the provisions of these regulations, the Sales Tax Regulations 1933,* so far as they are applicable and with the necessary modifications, shall apply for the purposes of the Act and of these regulations.
- (2) Clauses 8 to 17, 22 to 24, 25A, 26, 31, and 37 of the said regulations shall not apply.

Licences

4. (1) Every application for a wholesale distributor's licence under the Act shall be in form 1.

(2) Every wholesale distributor's licence shall be in form 2.

Returns

5. (1) The weekly return to be made by a licensee under section 13 of the Act shall be in form 3.

(2) The monthly return to be made by a licensee under the said

section 13 shall be in form 4.

(3) Every such return shall be delivered in accordance with the said section 13 whether or not any motor spirits are sold, used, or disposed of by the licensee during the week or month to which it relates, and whether or not any motor spirits duty is payable by him for that week or month.

Purchases by the Crown

6. Motor spirits duty shall not be levied, collected, or paid on any motor spirits purchased by or on behalf of the Crown for use as fuel for any aircraft for the time being used by the Royal New Zealand Air Force.

Minimum Duty Collectable

7. The minimum amount of motor spirits duty that need be collected in respect of any one return under section 13 of the Act shall be £1:

Provided that if the Collector has reason to believe that advantage is being taken of this regulation to avoid payment of motor spirits duty he may, subject to any direction that may be given by the Comptroller, require payment of motor spirits duty of less than £1.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations prescribe the forms for applications, licences, and returns under the Motor Spirits Duty Act 1961.

They also exempt from duty under that Act any motor spirits purchased by the Crown as fuel for aircraft used by the Royal New Zealand Air Force.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936. Date of notification in *Gazette*: 26 October 1961. These regulations are administered in the Customs Department.
