



**THE MILFORD SOUND HARBOUR REGULATIONS 1983,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 6 and 232 of the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Milford Sound Harbour Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Milford Sound Harbour Regulations 1983* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1986.

2. Berthage charges—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 6, and substituting the following regulation:

“6. (1) The master of any vessel that berths at the wharf at Deep Water Basin or berths alongside any vessel berthed at that wharf shall be liable to pay the berthage charges (if any) appropriate for the berthage of that vessel.

“(2) The berthage charges for every vessel that berths at the wharf at Deep Water Basin or that berths alongside any vessel berthed at that wharf shall be—

“(a) \$18 per metre or part metre of the overall length of the vessel, per year; or

“(b) 28 cents per metre or part metre of the overall length of the vessel, per day—

at the option of the master of the vessel.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations set berthage charges for all vessels that berth at the wharf at Deep Water Basin. The charges are \$18 per metre of length of vessel if paid on an annual basis, and 28 cents per metre of length of vessel if paid on a daily basis.

The charges apply on and from 1 April 1986.
