THE MEDICAL SUPPLIES NOTICE 1942, NO. 6

PURSUANT to Regulation 6 of the Medical Supplies Emergency Regulations 1939,* I, Michael Herbert Watt, Medical Supplies Controller, do hereby give notice as under :--

1. This notice may be cited as the Medical Supplies Notice 1942, No. 6.

2. No owner or person in possession of supplies of any goods named in the Schedule hereto shall, at any time after the day following the date of notification hereof in the *Gazette*, use otherwise than for use by himself and the members of his household, or dispose of, or part with the possession or control of, or otherwise deal with the said goods except by way of wholesale sale or retail sale made in accordance with clauses 3 and 4 respectively of this notice.

3. Until further notice, no sale by wholesale of any of the said goods shall be made except to a registered pharmaceutical chemist. The supply of the said goods shall not exceed a normal fortnight's supply.

4. Until further notice, none of the said goods shall be sold by retail except pursuant to an order signed by a registered medical practitioner and to the person named in such order.

5. No registered pharmaceutical chemist shall purchase any of the said goods if by virtue of such purchase and of stocks otherwise in his possession and control he becomes in possession or control of more than a normal fortnight's supply of the said goods regarded collectively.

SCHEDULE.

1. Rubber hot-water bags, moulded.
2. Rubber hot-water bags, fabricated.
