THE MEDICAL SUPPLIES NOTICE 1942, NO. 7

PURSUANT to Regulation 6 of the Medical Supplies Emergency Regulations 1939,* I, Michael Herbert Watt, Medical Supplies Controller, do hereby give notice as under :—

1. This notice may be cited as the Medical Supplies Notice 1942, No. 7, and shall come into force on the day following the date of notification hereof in the *Gazette*.

2. (1) The Medical Supplies Notice 1942, No. 6†, is hereby revoked.

(2) The revocation of the said notice shall not affect the liability of any person for any offence in relation thereto committed before this notice comes into force.

3. No owner or person in possession of supplies of any goods named in the Schedule hereto shall sell or dispose of, or part with the possession or control of, or otherwise deal with the said goods except by way of wholesale or retail sale, made in accordance with clauses 4 or 5 respectively of this notice.

4. Until further notice no sale by wholesale of any of the said goods shall be made except to a registered pharmaceutical chemist.

5. Until further notice none of the said goods shall be sold by retail except by a registered pharmaceutical chemist pursuant to an order signed by a registered medical practitioner acting in the practice of his profession, which order shall state the name of the patient and shall also state that the goods are required for the proper treatment of such patient.

1. Rubber hot-water bags, moulded.
2. Rubber hot-water bags, fabricated.
