Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 3 of the Motor Spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act, 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 20, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1942\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day following the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 18, are hereby revoked.

3. The First Schedule to the principal regulations (as substituted by the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 18) is hereby revoked, and the following substituted :—
