HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 3 of the Motor Spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act 1933, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 24, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1942* (herein-after referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 6th day of November 1952.

2. The Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No 23† are hereby revoked.

3. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule thereto (as substituted by the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 23) and substituting the following Schedule:—
