**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington, this 2nd day of June 1954

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 3 of the Motor Spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 26, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1942\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day following the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 25†, are hereby revoked.

3. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule thereto (as substituted by the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 25), and substituting the following schedule:
