THE MOTOR SPIRITS PRICES REGULATIONS 1942, AMENDMENT NO. 50

PURSUANT to the Motor Spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 50, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1942* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of March 1961.
- 2. For the purposes of the principal regulations premium-grade motor spirits are hereby declared to be motor spirits with an octane rating of 93 as measured by the standard method of test for knock characteristics of motor fuels below 100 octane rating by the research method (currently designated A.S.T.M. D. 908:59) as set out in the American Standards for Testing Material and as from time to time changed or modified.
 - 3. The principal regulations are hereby amended as follows:
 - (a) By omitting from regulation 6 the words "the First Schedule", and substituting the words "Part I of the First Schedule":
 - (b) By omitting from subclause (1) of regulation 8 the words "the First Schedule", and substituting the words "Part I of the First Schedule":

- (c) By omitting from regulation 9 (as amended by regulation 7 of the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 1) the words "set out in regulation 8 hereof", and substituting the words "fixed by regulation 8 hereof with respect to so much thereof as consists of standard-grade motor spirits and by regulation 10A (1) (b) hereof with respect to so much thereof as consists of premium-grade motor spirits":
- (d) By omitting from regulation 10 the words "the First Schedule", and substituting the words "Part I of the First Schedule".
- 4. The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 10, the following regulation:
 - "10a. (1) The minimum price and the maximum price—
 - "(a) At which a wholesaler may sell by wholesale premium-grade motor spirits for delivery in any particular sales area;
 - "(b) At which a wholesaler or a B depot agent may sell in the respective containers, or in bulk, premium-grade motor spirits to any bulk consumer in any particular sales area for delivery in that sales area; and
 - "(c) At which any person may sell premium-grade motor spirits for delivery in any particular sales area for cash payable on delivery thereof—

shall be the amounts set out in the columns headed 'Scale A', 'Scale B', and 'Scale D' respectively in Part II of the First Schedule hereto plus the appropriate differentials.

- "(2) Except as otherwise provided by this regulation, the provisions of these regulations relating to the sale of standard-grade motor spirits shall, as far as they are applicable and with the necessary modifications, apply to the sale of premium-grade motor spirits."
- 5. (1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule thereto (as substituted by the Motor Spirits Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 49) and substituting the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- (2) The Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 49,* are hereby revoked.
