**THE MOTOR SPIRITS PRICES REGULATIONS 1942,

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL
PURSUANT to the Motor Spirits (Regulations of Prices) Act 1933, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 54, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1942.*

2. Regulation 2 of the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 50†, is hereby amended by omitting the words "octane rating of 93", and substituting the words "octane rating of 96".

EXPLANATORY NOTE
