HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Motor Spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 55, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1942* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. The Third Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding to the description of Sales Area 43, after the word "commencement", the words "together with all that part of the Hawke's Bay Land District consisting of the Clive Riding of the Hawke's Bay County".
- 3. The Third Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby further amended by adding to the description of Sales Area 44, after the word "commencement", the words "but excluding therefrom all that part of the Hawke's Bay Land District consisting of the Clive Riding of the Hawke's Bay County".
