**THE MOTOR SPIRITS PRICES REGULATIONS 1967,  
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 18th day of September 1967

Present:

**THE RIGHT HON. KEITH HOLYOAKE, C.H., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to the Motor Spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1967, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1967\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 23rd day of September 1967.

**2. Main port prices for motor spirits**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule thereto and substituting the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

**3. Third Schedule amended**—The Third Schedule of the principal regulations is hereby amended as follows:

(a) Sales Area 30: By omitting so much thereof as relates to Sales Area 30, and substituting the following:

“The Motu, Waihuka, Ngatapa, and Karaka Ridings of Waikohu County. The Patutahi, Ormond, Waimata, Taruheru, and Pakarae Ridings of Cook County. That portion of Te Aroha Riding of Cook County to the west and north of a line commencing at a point on the Gisborne-Napier via Hangaroa road due south of Trig. Station XII; thence northerly to that Trig. Station easterly to Trig. Station 100 and a line due east to the boundary of the Te Aroha Riding. That portion of the Pouawa Riding of Cook County north of the southern boundaries of Blocks III and IV, Turanganui Survey District.”

(b) Sales Area 31: By omitting so much thereof as relates to Sales Area 31, and substituting the following:

"The Ridings of Gisborne, Whataupoko, Muriwai, Waingake, and Tiniroto of the Cook County. The Town District of Patutahi as described in the *Gazette* of 1917 at page 2049. That portion of the Te Aroha and Pouawa Ridings of Cook County to the south of the southern boundary of Sales Area 30 hereinbefore described. The City of Gisborne. The Whakatane County to the south of the southern boundary of Sales Area 23 hereinbefore described. The Waikaremoana and Ruakituri Ridings of Wairoa County.

(c) Sales Area 49: By omitting so much thereof as relates to Sales Area 49, and substituting the following:

"All that area in the Hawke's Bay Land District bounded on the north, west, and south by a line commencing on the sea coast in the middle of the mouth of the Esk River; thence westerly generally up the middle of that river to the middle of the Waipunga Road Bridge; thence south-westerly along a right line to the north-western corner of Section 77, Block XV, Puketapu Survey District; thence southerly along a right line to the confluence of the Ohiwia Stream and the Ngaruroro River, and a right line due south of that confluence to the Maraekakaho Road; thence south-easterly along a right line to the south-eastern corner of Turamoe No. 3 Block; thence easterly along a right line passing through the easternmost corner of Section 32, Block IV, Te Mata Survey District, to the Tukituki River; thence easterly along the southern boundary of the Riding of Clive of the Hawke's Bay County to the sea coast, and by the sea coast to the middle of the mouth of the Esk River, the point of commencement."
