ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 11th day of July 1969

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Motor Spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

—

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1967, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1967* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Main port prices for motor spirits—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1967, Amendment No. 4), and substituting the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) The Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1967, Amendment No. 4, are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations reduce the wholesale price of petrol to retailers by 0.25c per gallon. The retail price, and the wholesale price to bulk consumers, remain the same.

The difference between the wholesale price to bulk consumers and the wholesale price to retailers will now be 0.35c per gallon.
