**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 3rd day of November 1969

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Motor Spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1967, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1967\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Third Schedule amended**—The Third Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended as follows:

(a) By omitting so much thereof as relates to Sales Area 120, and substituting the following:

“Those portions of the Waihopai and Awarua Ridings of Southland County to the east of a line drawn from the intersection of the sea coast with the eastern boundary of Block 15, Oteramika Hundred north to Trig. 0 in Block 3, Oteramika Hundred, northerly to Trig. E in Block 11, Oteramika Hundred, north-westerly to Trig. K in Block 8, Lothian Hundred, westerly to Trig. A in Block 7, Mabel Hundred, north-westerly to Trig. F in Block 2, Mabel Hundred, and

northerly through Trig. Titipua to the middle of the Makarewa River on the north-western boundary of Awarua Riding aforesaid. Those portions of the Hokonui, Mataura, and Toetoes Ridings of Southland County west of the western boundary of Sales Area 119 hereinbefore described. The Winton Riding of Southland County. The Boroughs of Winton, Gore, and Mataura. The Independent Town District of Wyndham. The Otautau, Aparima, Pourakino, and Waimatuka Ridings of Wallace County. The Independent Town District of Otautau. The Borough of Riverton.”:

- (b) By omitting so much thereof as relates to Sales Area 121, and substituting the following:

“All that area in the Southland Land District bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of the sea coast with the eastern boundary of Block 15, Oteramika Hundred, north to Trig. O in Block 3, Oteramika Hundred, northerly to Trig. E in Block 11, Oteramika Hundred, north-westerly to Trig. K in Block 8, Lothian Hundred, westerly to Trig. A in Block 7, Mabel Hundred, north-westerly to Trig. F in Block 2, Mabel Hundred, and northerly through Trig. Titipua to the middle of the Makarewa River on the north-western boundary of Awarua Riding aforesaid; thence northerly along that Riding boundary to the northern boundary of Wallacetown Riding, westerly along that Riding boundary to the western boundary of Southland County; thence southerly along the Southland County boundary aforesaid to the sea; thence by the sea coast to Stirling Point and thence along a right line across the entrance to Bluff Harbour to Tiwai Point; thence south-easterly along the sea coast to the point of commencement; except all that area in the Southland Land District bounded by the Free Delivery Area of Sales Area 122 hereinafter described.”

These regulations amend the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1967 by adjusting the boundaries of Sales Area 120 and Sales Area 121.
