THE MOTOR SPIRITS PRICES REGULATIONS 1970,  
AMENDMENT NO. 1

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 3rd day of May 1971

Present:

THE HON. J. RAE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Motor Spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1970, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1970\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Regulations not to apply in certain areas**—Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the following subclause:

“(2) Nothing in these regulations shall apply in respect of Kawau Island.”

**3. Wholesale sales in certain areas**—Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting before the words “regulation 3”, the words “subclause (1) of”.

**4. Prices for motor spirits**—The principal regulations are hereby further amended by revoking the Schedule, and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

Regulation 2 provides that nothing in the principal regulations is to apply in respect of Kawau Island.

Regulation 3 is a consequential amendment.

Regulation 4 increases the wholesale and retail price of motor spirits by 2c per gallon.
