**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 14th day of June 1982

PURSUANT to the Motor Spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1981\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 15th day of June 1982.

**2. New Schedule substituted**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Schedule (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 3), and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

**3. Revocation**—The Motor Spirits Prices Regulations 1981, Amendment No. 3 are hereby consequentially revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 15 June 1982, increase the bulk consumer and retail prices of motor spirits by 4c per litre and the wholesale price by 3.41c per litre. The retailer's margin is thus increased by 0.59c per litre.

NOTE—The prices shown in the Schedule do not include any local authorities petroleum tax (maximum rate 0.66c per litre) or Chatham Islands dues or county dues which may be payable.
