PURSUANT to sections 1 (2) and 221 of the Maritime Transport Act 1994, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Maritime Transport Act Commencement Order 1997.

2. Commencement of Part XXII of Maritime Transport Act 1994—Part XXII of the Maritime Transport Act 1994 comes into force on 19 December 1997.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
