



**THE METRICATION (RETAIL TRADING) REGULATIONS 1978,

PURSUANT to section 39 of the Weights and Measures Act 1925 and to section 3 of the Weights and Measures Amendment Act 1976, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Metrication (Retail Trading) Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Metrication (Retail Trading) Regulations 1978* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1984.

2. First Schedule amended—The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the item relating to chocolate powder, and substituting the following item:

“Chocolate powder 100g, 250g, 400g, 500g, or multiples of 500g.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 July 1984, vary the requirements concerning retail sales of chocolate powder in standard metric packages. As a result of the variation chocolate powder may, on and after 1 July 1984, be sold by retail in a package of 400g net weight. On and after that date, each package of chocolate powder must then have a net weight of 100g, 250g, 400g, 500g, or a multiple of 500g.
