## HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 39 of the Weights and Measures Act 1925 and to section 3 of the Weights and Measures Amendment Act 1976, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Metrication (Retail Trading) Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Metrication (Retail Trading) Regulations 1978\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
  - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of May 1985.
- 2. First Schedule amended—(1) The First Schedule to the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 3 of the Metrication (Retail Trading) Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 1) is hereby amended by omitting the items relating to milk, and substituting the following items:

150 ml, 300 ml, or 600 ml.

"Milk as defined in section 2 of the Milk Act 1967 (but not including cream) which has been treated by the ultra heat treatment process

250 ml, 500 ml, or 1 litre."

(2) Regulation 3 of the Metrication (Retail Trading) Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 1 is hereby consequentially revoked.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 May 1985, vary the requirements relating to standard metric packages of milk treated by the ultra heat treatment process. Under the existing regulations milk which has been treated by the ultra heat treatment process may only be sold by retail in 250 ml or 500 ml packages. On and after 1 May 1985 it may also be sold in 1 litre packages.
