



**THE METRICATION (RETAIL TRADING) REGULATIONS 1978,
AMENDMENT NO. 6**

PURSUANT to section 39 of the Weights and Measures Act 1925 and to section 3 of the Weights and Measures Amendment Act 1976, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Metrication (Retail Trading) Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Metrication (Retail Trading) Regulations 1978* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of December 1986.

2. First Schedule amended—The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the item relating to honey (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Metrication (Retail Trading) Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 5), and substituting the following item:

“Honey (other than honey in the 250g, 500g, 750g, 900g, 1kg, or comb) multiples of 1 kg”.

3. Revocation—The Metrication (Retail Trading) Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 5 are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 December 1986, vary the requirements relating to retail sales of honey in standard metric packages. Under the existing regulations honey may only be sold by retail in packages of 250g, 500g, 900g, 1 kg, or multiples of 1 kg. On and after 1 December 1986 it may also be sold in packages of 750g.
