PURSUANT to the Music Teachers Registration Act 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Music Teachers Registration Regulations 1966, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Music Teachers Registration Regulations 1966\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of March 1977.

**2. Annual registration fee**—(1) Regulation 15 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 of the Music Teachers Registration Regulations 1966, Amendment No. 1) is hereby amended by omitting the expression "\$2.10", and substituting the expression "\$10".

(2) The Music Teachers Registration Regulations 1966, Amendment No. 1 are hereby consequentially revoked.

**3. Application fee**—Paragraph F of the form numbered 1 in the First Schedule to the principal regulations (as amended by section 7 of the Decimal Currency Act 1964) is hereby amended by omitting the expression "\$1.50", and substituting the expression "\$10".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These amendments amend the Music Teachers Registration Regulations 1966. *Regulation 1* relates to the Title and commencement. The regulations come into force on 1 March 1977.

*Regulation 2* increases the annual registration fee from \$2.10 to \$10.

*Regulation 3* increases the fee payable on application for registration from \$1.50 to \$10.
