EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order is consequential upon the Milk Stations Regulations 1979. However, as the Milk Treatment Regulations 1969 were made and confirmed by legislation under and in accordance with the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act 1934, their revocation must be confirmed by legislation. Hence the need for this separate order.
