



**THE MOTOR VEHICLE DEALERS REGULATIONS 1980,
AMENDMENT NO. 3**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 148 of the Motor Vehicle Dealers Act 1975, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicle Dealers Regulations 1980, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor Vehicle Dealers Regulations 1980* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1992.

2. New scale of fees substituted in principal regulations—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Third Schedule (as substituted by regulation 3 of the Motor Vehicle Dealers Regulations

1980, Amendment No. 2), and substituting the Third Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

3. Amount of goods and services tax included—The fees prescribed by the principal regulations are inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.

4. Revocations—Regulation 3 of, and the Second Schedule to, the Motor Vehicle Dealers Regulations 1980, Amendment No. 2 are hereby consequentially revoked.

FEES PAYABLE IN RESPECT OF MATTERS UNDER THE MOTOR VEHICLE DEALERS ACT 1975

1. On application for a licence	700
2. On renewal of a licence	140
3. On application for the removal of a licence	50
4. On application for the approval of a subsidiary place of business	50
5. On application for the approval of a chief executive officer of a licensee company	50
6. On application for the approval of a person to supervise a licensee’s business during temporary absence or incapacity	50
7. On consent to employment of an officer of a licensee company or branch office, except where the consent is applied for with an application for the grant or renewal of a licence	50
8. On application for a certificate of approval	50
9. For the renewal of a certificate of approval	10
10. For the issue of a duplicate licence or certificate of approval	50
11. For the approval of a person (not being a chief executive officer of a company) to supervise the conduct of a licensee company’s business from its principal place of business	50
12. For the provision of a written copy of an entry in any register the Registrar may charge a maximum fee of	10.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 January 1992, substitute a new scale of fees for various matters under the Motor Vehicle Dealers Act 1975. The fees are inclusive of goods and services tax.
