THE MOTOR VEHICLES (LICENSING FEES EXEMPTION) NOTICE 1965

PURSUANT to paragraph (38) of the First Schedule to the Motor Vehicles (Licensing Fees Exemption) Regulations 1961,* the Minister of Transport hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

- 1. This notice may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Licensing Fees Exemption) Notice 1965.
- 2. Machinery of the kinds specified in the Schedule to this notice is hereby approved for the purposes of the First Schedule to the Motor Vehicles (Licensing Fees) Exemption Regulations 1961.*
- 3. The notice by the Minister of Transport dated the 25th day of November 1963† exempting television stations from the payment of annual licence fees is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

(1) Television stations which are permanently attached to motor vehicles owned by the New Zealand Broadcasting Corporation and designed and used on roads exclusively for carrying such stations.

(2) Steam-cleaning plants which are permanently attached to motor vehicles designed and used on roads exclusively for carrying such plant.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect. The effect of this notice is to exempt motor vehicles owned by the New Zealand Broadcasting Corporation and designed exclusively for carrying television stations and motor vehicles designed exclusively for carrying steam-cleaning plants from annual licence fees under Part II of the Transport Act 1962.
