**THE MOTOR VEHICLES (LICENSING FEES EXEMPTION)
REGULATIONS 1948, AMENDMENT NO. 3**

THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Licensing Fees Exemption) Regulations 1948, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor Vehicles (Licensing Fees Exemption) Regulations 1948* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the following clause:

“(5) Any motor vehicle owned and used by a person carrying on business as a farmer or agricultural contractor and approved by the Minister by notice in the *Gazette* for exemption under this Schedule on the grounds that by reason of its design or permanent adaptation in its design it is suitable for use only in connection with the owner’s business as a farmer or agricultural contractor and is not capable of a speed exceeding twenty miles an hour.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

These regulations exempt from the payment of annual licence fees motor vehicles used by farmers or agricultural contractors which are so designed or adapted that they can be used only for agricultural purposes and are incapable of a speed of more than 20 miles an hour.
