HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Transport Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Licensing Fees Exemption) Regulations 1948, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor Vehicles (Licensing Fees Exemption) Regulations 1948* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. The Second Schedule to the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 of the Motor Vehicles (Licensing Fees Exemption) Regulations 1948, Amendment No. 3) is hereby further amended by adding the following clause:
- "(6) Any tractor owned and used by a person carrying on business as a farmer or agricultural contractor and not used on a road for haulage purposes, except for the haulage on its own wheels, and not by means of a trailer, of an agricultural implement or agricultural machine."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations exempt from the payment of annual licence fees tractors owned and used by farmers and agricultural contractors and not used on any road for haulage, except the haulage on its own wheels of an agricultural implement or an agricultural machine. If an agricultural implement or an agricultural machine is carried on a trailer towed by the tractor, the tractor will not qualify for exemption.
