THE MOTOR VEHICLES (LICENSING FEES EXEMPTION) REGULATIONS 1961, AMENDMENT NO. 1

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 28th day of June 1961

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Transport Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Licensing Fees Exemption) Regulations 1961, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor Vehicles (Licensing Fees Exemption) Regulations 1961* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. The Third Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the following clauses:
- "(9) Any tractor owned by Heavy Haulage Limited of Invercargill, which is used exclusively on the Island Wharf at Bluff for shunting or towing purposes and remains permanently on that wharf and is not used on a public highway.
- "(10) Any trailer owned by a shipping company or stevedoring contractor and used exclusively in connection with the embarking and disembarking of ships' passengers or for loading and unloading ships' mails, cargo, and passengers' baggage on the Auckland wharves, and used on a public highway only when proceeding unladen from one wharf to another wharf or from its usual place of storage to a wharf and in returning to that place of storage.

"(11) Any motor vehicle owned by A. D. Campbell and Company Limited of Browns, which is used on a road only in crossing Settlers Road, Browns, in the Southland County at a point approximately 10 chains south of the No. 96 State Highway (Mataura-Tuatapere) by means of a concrete road-crossing constructed and maintained by the said company on the route from the company's land on one side of the said road to the company's land on the other side."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

The effect of these regulations is to exempt from payment of annual licence fees the classes of motor vehicles described in the regulations.
