ORDER IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Motor-Vehicles Insurance (Third-Party Risks) Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor-Vehicles Insurance (Third-Party Risks) Regulations 1963* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
 - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1966.
- 2. Regulation 5 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 of the Motor-Vehicles Insurance (Third-Party Risks) Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 2) is hereby further amended by omitting from subclause (1) the words "1st day of July 1965", and substituting the words "1st day of July 1966".
- 3. The principal regulations are hereby further amended by revoking the First Schedule (as substituted by regulation 3 of the Motor-Vehicles Insurance (Third-Party Risks) Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 2), and substituting the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- **4.** The Motor-Vehicles Insurance (Third-Party Risks) Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 2, are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations provide the schedule of annual third-party insurance premiums payable as from 1 July 1966 in respect of licensed motor vehicles.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936. Date of notification in *Gazette*: 6 April 1966. These regulations are administered in the Transport Department.
