THE RIGHT HON. R. D. MULDOON PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Motor Vehicles Indemnity Surcharge Regulations Revocation Order 1980.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of May 1980.

2. Revocations—The following regulations are hereby revoked:

- (a) The Motor Vehicles Indemnity Surcharge Regulations 1974*;
- (b) The Motor Vehicles Indemnity Surcharge Regulations 1974, Amendment No. 4†.

3. Saving—Notwithstanding the provisions of this order, the annual indemnity surcharges payable under Part VIA of the Transport Act 1962 for the licensing year ending with the 30th day of June 1980 shall be the surcharges prescribed immediately before the commencement of this order, and any refund of an indemnity surcharge paid for the whole or part of that year in respect of any motor vehicle shall be the refund that would have been made if this order had not been made.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order revokes the Motor Vehicles Indemnity Surcharge Regulations 1974 with effect from the end of the current licensing year.
