PURSUANT to sections 24 and 199 of the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency
the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the
Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title, commencement, and application—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles Registration and Licensing Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 10, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Motor Vehicle Registration and Licensing Regulations 1965* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date

of their notification in the Gazette.

- (3) These regulations shall not apply in relation to the issue of any licence in respect of the licensing year that commenced on the 1st day of July 1983.
- 2. Interpretation—Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the definitions of the terms "contract motor vehicle", "omnibus", "passenger truck", "private taxicab", "public motor vehicle", "public taxicab", "rental car", and "service coach".
- **8. Form of licences**—(1) Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclauses (1) and (2), and substituting the following subclauses:
- "(1) Except as provided in subclause (2) of this regulation, the licences to use motor vehicles of the following classes shall be in the following forms:
 - "(a) For every motor cycle, other than a motor cycle to which paragraph (g) of this subclause applies, the licence shall be in the form of Diagram No. 1 in the First Schedule to these regulations:
 - "(b) For every moped, light trailer, heavy trailer, or tractor, other than a vehicle to which paragraph (c) or paragraph (f) or paragraph (g) of this subclause applies, the licence shall be in the form of Diagram No. 3 in that Schedule:
 - "(c) For every heavy trailer that is required to have a certificate of fitness or permit, the licence shall be in the form of Diagram No. 4 in that Schedule:
 - "(d) For every motorcar, other than a motorcar to which paragraph (e) or paragraph (f) of this subclause applies, the licence shall be in the form of Diagram No. 6 in that Schedule:
 - "(e) For every motor vehicle that is required to have a certificate of fitness or permit, other than a vehicle to which paragraph (f) or paragraph (g) of this subclause applies, the licence shall be in the form of Diagram No. 7 in that Schedule:
 - "(f) For every motor vehicle operated under a transport licence, other than a trailer or a vehicle to which paragraph (g) of this subclause applies, the licence shall be in the form of Diagram No. 8 in that Schedule:
 - "(g) For every moped or motor cycle operated under a transport licence, the licence shall be in the form of Diagram No. 9 in that Schedule:
 - "(h) For every motor vehicle for which the form of licence is not prescribed by any other paragraph of this subclause, the licence shall be in the form of Diagram No. 10 in that Schedule.
- "(2) The licences to use motor vehicles of the following classes shall be in the following forms:
 - "(a) For every motor cycle or moped to which there is required to be attached a learner's licence label, the licence shall be in the form of Diagram No. 2 in the First Schedule to these regulations:
 - "(b) For every motor vehicle operated under section 22 of the Act (which relates to trade plates) or of a kind specified in Schedule 1A to these regulations, the licence shall be in the form of Diagram No. 3 in the First Schedule to these regulations:
 - "(c) For every motor vehicle that is an exempted vehicle within the meaning of section 187 of the Act, the licence shall be in the form of Diagram No. 5 in the First Schedule to these regulations."
- (2) The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking Diagram 8 and the heading of Diagram 9, and substituting the diagrams and headings set out in the First Schedule to these regulations.

- 4. Amendments consequential upon Transport Amendment Act (No. 2) 1988—The regulations specified in the first column of the Second Schedule to these regulations are hereby amended in the manner indicated in the second column of that Schedule.
- **5. Consequential revocations**—The regulations specified in the Third Schedule to these regulations are hereby consequentially revoked.





EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which apply in respect of the licensing year beginning with 1 July 1984 and future licensing years, amend the Motor Vehicle Registration and Licensing Regulations 1965.

The principal change is that vehicles (other than trailers) that are operated under transport licences will have annual licensing labels bearing the letter "T" rather than the letter "K" as at present.

at present.
Other changes include the revocation of redundant provisions, and changes to references to provisions of the Transport Act 1962 following amendments made to that Act last year.
