**THE MOTOR VEHICLE TAXATION REGULATIONS 1963,

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicle Taxation Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and form part of the Motor Vehicle Taxation Regulations 1963* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "a receipted invoice" and substituting the words "an invoice".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations abolish the requirement that the invoice relating to the purchase of the motor spirits that must be produced by an applicant for a rebate of motor spirits tax must be a receipted invoice.
