A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to subsection (2) of section 1 of the Navy Act 1954, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim as follows:

1. This Proclamation may be cited as the Navy Act Commencement Order 1958.
2. The Navy Act 1954 shall come into force on the 1st day of February 1958.
