PURSUANT to section 5 (1) and section 8 (2) of the Area Health Boards Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice of the Minister of Health tendered at the request of the Nelson Hospital Board, and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Nelson Area Health District Order 1985.

2. Establishment of Nelson Area Health District—The Nelson Hospital District shall, on the 1st day of October 1985, become an area health district under the name of the Nelson Area Health District.

3. Number of representatives of constituent districts—The number of representatives on the Nelson Area Health Board (established by section 6 (1) of the Area Health Boards Act 1983 for the Nelson Area Health District) of each constituent district within the area health district shall be as specified in the Schedule to this order.
