ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 26th day of October, 1938.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Nurses and Midwives Registration Act, 1925, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Nurses and Midwives Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 1.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Nurses and Midwives Regulations 1938* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.
- 4. Regulation 17 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking paragraph (b) thereof, and substituting:—
 - "(b) In-patients: For confinement and after-treatment for a period of fourteen days, £5 5s.: Provided that when a patient is discharged by the hospital authorities before the end of that period the fee shall be reduced by 6s. for each unexpired day of the said period."
