Pursuant to the Nurses and Midwives Act 1945, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Nurses and Midwives Regulations 1947, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Nurses and Midwives Regulations 1947* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Regulation 30 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (a) of subclause (2) the words "eighteen years and six months", and substituting the words "eighteen years".
- 3. Regulation 40 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after subclause (6), the following subclause:—
- "(6A) The fee for the issue of an annual practising certificate under section 28 of the said Act shall be 5s."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

 $[This \ note \ is \ not \ part \ of \ the \ regulations, \ but \ is \ intended \ to \ indicate \ their \ general \ effect.]$

By these regulations the age at which nursing aids may sit the State Examination is reduced by six months; and a fee of 5s. a year prescribed for the issue of an annual practising certificate for nurses.
