Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Nurses and Midwives Registration Board Emergency Regulations 1944.
- 2. Notwithstanding anything in section 4 of the Nurses and Midwives Registration Act, 1925,* each of the persons whose names are specified in the Schedule hereto, being persons appointed under subsection (2) (d) of the said section 4 to be members, as from the 1st day of March, 1941, of the Nurses and Midwives Registration Board†, shall continue to hold office as a member of the Board until her successor is appointed pursuant to the said section 4, and shall not be deemed to have vacated her office by reason of the period for which she was appointed having expired before the commencement of these regulations.
