PURSUANT to section 1 (3) of the National Bank of New Zealand Limited Act 1994, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title**—This Order may be cited as the National Bank of New Zealand Limited Act Commencement Order 1994.

**2. Commencement of sections 4 to 10, 13, 14, and 15 of National Bank of New Zealand Limited Act 1994**—Sections 4 to 10, 13, 14, and 15 of the National Bank of New Zealand Limited Act 1994 shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1994.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order brings into force, on 1 July 1994, sections 4 to 10, 13, 14, and 15 of the National Bank of New Zealand Limited Act 1994. The effect of the order is that on that date—

- (a) The undertaking of The Rural Bank Limited is transferred to The National Bank of New Zealand Limited; and
- (b) The Rural Bank Limited is dissolved.
