ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 4th day of
August, 1943

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Naval Discipline Emergency Regulations 1943.

2. While these regulations continue in force, section 58 of the Naval Discipline Act, 1866, in its application to the Royal New Zealand Navy pursuant to section 18 of the Naval Defence Act, 1913,* shall be read as if it had been amended by repealing paragraph (3) (which provides that a court-martial shall not be held unless at least two of His Majesty's ships, not being tenders, and commanded by captains, commanders, lieutenant-commanders, or lieutenants of His Majesty's Navy on full pay, are together at the time when such court-martial is held).
