THE NOTIFIABLE DISEASES NOTICE 1953

C. W. M. NORRIE, Governor-General

PURSUANT to the Health Act 1920, His Excellency the Governor-General hereby gives notice as follows.

NOTICE

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Notifiable Diseases Notice 1953.
- (2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of March 1953.
2. The diseases specified in the Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be notifiable diseases within the meaning of the Health Act 1920.

SCHEDULE

1. Skin diseases arising from occupation.
2. Any damage to eyesight arising from occupation.
3. Impaired hearing arising from occupation.
4. Diseases of the respiratory system arising from occupation.
5. Poisoning from any insecticide, weedicide, fungicide, or animal poison met with at work.
6. Poisoning from any gas, fumigant, or refrigerant met with at work.
7. Poisoning from any solvent met with at work.
8. Poisoning from any metal or salt of metal met with at work.
