PURSUANT to the Health Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Notifiable Diseases Order 1965.

2. The Second Schedule to the Health Act 1956 is hereby amended by adding to the list of notifiable diseases set out therein the word "Trichinosis".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect. The effect of this order is to make trichinosis a notifiable disease under the Health Act 1956.
