

THE NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER 1980

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 18th day of August 1980 Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Whereas His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, considers that the works described in clause 2 of this order together constitute a private work that is a major work likely to be in the national interest and considers that—

- (a) The work is essential for the purposes of—
 - (i) The orderly production, development, and utilisation of New Zealand's resources;
 - (ii) The major expansion of exports; and
 - (iii) The development of significant opportunities for employment; and
- (b) It is essential a decision be made promptly as to whether or not the consents sought in respect of that work should be granted: Now, therefore, pursuant to section 3 (3) of the National Development Act 1979, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the National Development Order 1980.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. National Development Act 1979 applied—The provisions of the National Development Act 1979 are hereby applied to the following private works:

- (a) The construction and operation by or on behalf of Petralgas Chemicals NZ Limited, a duly incorporated company having its registered office in Wellington, of a plant for the production of methanol at Mamaku Road, Waitara:
- (b) The construction and operation by or on behalf of that company of a barge dock site on the western bank of the Waitara River, together with a hard standing area and access road, for the receipt, storage, and transportation of plant and equipment in connection with the construction of the work referred to in paragraph (a) of this clause:
- (c) The construction and operation by or on behalf of that company of methanol storage tanks and associated pipelines and facilities at Port Taranaki, New Plymouth:
- (d) The construction and operation by or on behalf of that company of a pipeline and associated plant and equipment for the conveyance of methanol from the methanol plant referred to in paragraph (a) of this clause to the methanol storage tanks referred to in paragraph (c) of this clause.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect. This order applies the provisions of the National Development Act 1979 to the methanol plant proposed to be constructed and operated at Waitara by Petralgas Chemicals NZ Limited, and to associated works.
