**THE NAVAL ENLISTMENT EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1942**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL.**

At the Government House at Wellington, this 20th day of  
May, 1942.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS.**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Naval Enlistment Emergency Regulations 1942.

2. The regulations to be cited as the Naval Mobilization Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 2,\* are hereby revoked.

3. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (2) of section 10 of the Naval Defence Act, 1913, enlistment in the Royal New Zealand Navy may, at the discretion of the Naval Board (to be exercised either generally or in respect of particular cases or particular classes of personnel), be for a period ending six months after the final official termination of the hostilities existing at the time of enlistment or arising at any time during the period of the engagement between His Majesty and enemy powers, with power to the Naval Board to determine the engagement at any earlier date.

4. Any enlistment expressed to be for the duration of hostilities and six months afterwards shall be deemed to be an enlistment on the terms set out in the last preceding regulation.

5. Any engagement heretofore entered into since the coming into force of the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, and expressed to be for a period depending on or in any way connected with duration of hostilities shall be deemed to be an engagement entered into in terms of Regulation 3 hereof.
