ORDER IN COUNCIL

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Orchard and Garden Diseases Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the New-Zealand-grown Fruit Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 4.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the New-Zealand-grown Fruit Regulations 1940 (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. Regulation 21 of the principal regulations and the New-Zealand-grown Fruit Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 1, are revoked.

4. Regulation 23 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended as follows :—

- (i) By revoking the words “ inspection-fee stamp or other ” in paragraph (e) thereof ;
- (ii) By revoking the words “ counterfeit inspection-fee stamp or other ” in paragraph (f) thereof ;
- (iii) By revoking paragraphs (g) and (h) thereof.
