THE NARCOTICS ORDER (NO. 2) 1967

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Narcotics Act 1965, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. (1) This order may be cited as the Narcotics Order (No. 2) 1967.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the fourth day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. The First Schedule to the Narcotics Act 1965 is hereby amended by inserting in clause 1, in their appropriate alphabetical order, the following names of substances:
 - "LYSERGIDE, (N,N diethyl-lysergamide).
 - "MESCALINE, (3,4,5-trimethyloxyphenethylamine).
 - "PEYOTL—that is, any part of the plant of the species Lophophora williamsii or Lophophora lewinii."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect. This order amends the Narcotics Act 1965 by making lysergide (also known as LSD, LSD25, lysergic acid diethylamide), mescaline (also known as mescalin), and peyotl (also known as peyote) narcotics within the meaning of that Act.
