THE NATIONAL PROVIDENT FUND REGULATIONS 1927, AMENDMENT NO. 6.

GALWAY, Governor-General. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 7th day of December, 1939.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the National Provident Fund Act, 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the National Provident Fund Regulations 1927, Amendment No. 6.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the National Provident Fund Regulations 1927* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. Clause (5) of Regulation 7 of the principal regulations is revoked,

and the following clause substituted:

- "(5) The amount of contributions paid in advance in respect of a period not less than three years shall be reduced for every shilling a week of such contributions by a sum not less than the amount set out in the second column of the table comprising Form No. 2 in the Second Schedule hereto, and not more than the amount set out in the third column of the said table.'
- **4.** A married contributor who desires to exercise a right of election conferred by section 31 of the Finance Act (No. 2), 1939, shall make application to the Superintendent in form No. 13 of the Second Schedule to the principal regulations (as added to the principal regulations by the National Provident Fund Regulations 1930, Amendment No. 2), modified as may be necessary to meet the circumstances of the particular case.

5. The medical evidence to be obtained by the Board with respect to a contributor electing to receive joint or successive pensions pursuant to subsection (2) of section 31 of the Finance Act (No. 2), 1939, shall in the first instance be a certificate from a registered medical practitioner:

Provided that in any particular case the Board may require a further certificate or oral or other testimony from some other registered

medical practitioner approved by the Board.

- 6. The maximum amount of pension to be actuarially computed pursuant to subsection (4) of section 31 of the Finance Act (No. 2), 1939, shall be computed by the Government Actuary having regard to the health of the contributor and to the ages of the contributor and his wife.
- 7. Regulation 34 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking all the words after the word "Superintendent."
- 8. Regulation 44 of the principal regulations is amended by adding to clause (1) thereof the following words: "which amount shall thereupon be payable by the society to the Superintendent."
- 9. Regulation 44 of the principal regulations is further amended by revoking clause (2) thereof, and substituting the following clause:—
- "(2) At the end of each calendar month the Superintendent shall cause to be paid to the member the amount of pension due for that month, after taking into account any moneys due and payable by the member to his society."
- 10. Form No. 2 in the Second Schedule to the principal regulations is revoked, and the following substituted:—
