**THE NATURALIZATION REGULATIONS 1929,
AMENDMENT NO. 3.**

GALWAY, Governor-General.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 16th day of June, 1939.

Present :

THE RIGHT HON. M. J. SAVAGE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the British Nationality and Status of Aliens (in New Zealand) Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Naturalization Regulations 1929, Amendment No. 3.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Naturalization Regulations 1929* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.

4. Regulation 9 of the principal regulations (as heretofore amended by Regulation 2 of the Naturalization Amendment Regulations 1935)† is revoked, and the following substituted :—

“ 9. (1) A declaration of alienage or declaration of retention or resumption or acquisition of British nationality may be made before a Stipendiary Magistrate, but not otherwise. Every such declaration shall be registered in the Department of Internal Affairs at Wellington.

“ (2) For the purpose of securing the registration of declarations of alienage or of the retention or resumption or acquisition of British nationality the following provisions shall apply :—

“ (a) Every such declaration shall be subscribed in duplicate :

“ (b) The Stipendiary Magistrate taking any such declaration shall transmit to the Department of Internal Affairs at Wellington the two copies thereof :

“ (c) On payment by the declarant of the prescribed fee for registration, one copy shall be officially noted as having been registered and shall be returned to the declarant, and the other copy shall be filed in the Department.”
